Requirement	Description
Filing Applications	<p>Applications for tourist and business visa applications can be filed at a Zambian High Commission in the following location:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> · Pretoria <p>If your current location does not have a Zambian mission nearby for filing the application, please contact us for more information.</p>
Visa Exemptions	<p>The following nationalities are visa-exempt for tourist and business purposes in Zambia: Angola,, Antigua and Barbuda, Barbados, Belize, Botswana, Cyprus, Dominica, Eswatini, Fiji, Grenada, Hong Kong, Ireland, Jamaica, Kenya, Kiribati, Lesotho, Malawi, Malaysia, Maldives, Malta, Marshall Islands, Mauritius, Montenegro, Mozambique, Namibia, Nauru, Romania, Saint Kitts and Nevis, Saint Lucia, Saint Vincent and the Grenadines, Samoa, Seychelles, Singapore, Solomon Islands, South Africa, ZAMBIA, Tonga, Trinidad and Tobago, Tuvalu, Uganda, Vanuatu, Zimbabwe.</p>
Passport	A valid passport with at least 6 months validity from the date of return from the scheduled trip with at least 3 blank pages at date of submission.
	A copy of passport bio-data page.
ID	A copy of your ID document.
Application Form	A completed application form signed by the applicant.
Passport Photos	Two (2) recent colour passport photographs.
Flight Itinerary	A copy of a flight itinerary with a return flight to/from Zambia.
Proof of financial means	Evidence of sufficient funds to cover entire stay in Zambia.
Yellow Fever Certificate	A certified copy of a yellow fever certificate.
Accommodation	Proof of accommodation such as a hotel booking.
Letter of Invitation	For business applications only, a letter of invitation from a Zambian company indicating the nature of your business activities in Zambia, passport details, and expected duration of stay as well as accepting full immigration responsibility for your stay in Zambia. A copy of the ID document of the Zambian company's signatory must be included.
Employer Letter	For business applications only, a letter from your current employer indicating the nature of your business activities in Zambia and assuming responsibility for any financial, medical, and accommodation expenses.
Processing times	24 to 48 hours.
